



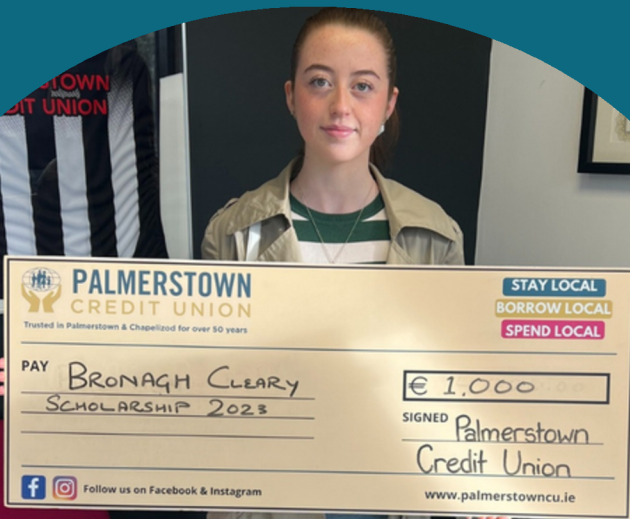

Rules of the Award

- Scholarship recipients must provide evidence of progression to the next academic year of their course. Failure to do so may result in the scholarship being suspended until progression is confirmed.
- Any recipient wishing to defer their scholarship for one academic year must receive prior approval from Palmerstown Credit Union.
- If a recipient chooses to change course or faculty during their studies, the scholarship will only be awarded for the duration of the original course.

Recipient Commitments

- By accepting the 3rd Level Scholarship, recipients agree to:
- Become a member of the Palmerstown Credit Union Youth Committee for the duration of their course.
- Attend a minimum of six Youth Committee meetings per year, beginning in October following receipt of the bursary.
- Participate in at least three voluntary events hosted by Palmerstown Credit Union each year (e.g. School Quiz, Art Competition, Pobalfactor).
- Actively contribute to Youth Committee initiatives and activities.
- Assist in the delivery of Money Smart modules.

Please note: Failure to meet these commitments may result in the suspension or withdrawal of the scholarship.
